

Round-Robin, Luck-of-the-Draw Charity Pickleball Tournament - 30 players - 6 courts

A draw will be made to divide 5 players per courts. Each player plays a rally round robin of 10 minutes against each of the other 4 players following this draw:

| Round 1 | Round 2 | Round 3 | Round 4 | Round 5 |
|------------|------------|------------|------------|------------|
| 1-2 vs 3-4 | 1-3 vs 2-5 | 1-5 vs 2-4 | 1-4 vs 3-5 | 2-3 vs 4-5 |
| 5 (Bye) | 4 (Bye) | 3 (Bye) | 2 (Bye) | 1 (Bye) |

Players will be ranked (1 to 30) by their total points made during their 4 games.

The 24 best players will be divided in 3 pools: players ranked 1 to 8 in pool A, players ranked 9 to 16 in Pool B, and players ranked 17 to 24 in Pool C. They will continue to play a rally round robin of 15 points against another team following the above draw:

| Pool A (1st & 2nd place) | Pool B (3 rd &4 th place) | Pool C (5 th & 6 th place) |
|--------------------------|---|--|
| Court # 1: 1-5 vs 3-7 | Court # 3: 9-13 vs 11-15 | Court # 5: 17-21 vs 19-23 |
| Court # 2: 2-6 vs 4-8 | Court # 4: 10-14 vs 12-16 | Court # 6: 18-22 vs 20-24 |

In each pool, the winning team of each game will continue to play a rally round robin of 21 points against the other winning team following the above draw:

| Pool A (1st & 2nd place) | Pool B (3 rd &4 th place) | Pool C (5 th & 6 th place) |
|---------------------------|---|--|
| Court #1: Winner of court | Court #2: Winner of court | Court #3: Winner of court |
| 1 vs Winner of court 2 | 3 vs Winner of court 4 | 5 vs Winner of court 6 |

- The winning team of Pool A will have the gold medal and the losing team, the silver medal.
- The winning team of Pool B will have the bronze medal and the losing team, the 4th place.
- The winning team of Pool C will have the 5th place and the losing team, the 6th place.
